

**JOB ANNOUNCEMENT
SHELTER OUR SISTERS
PROJECT CHILD PROGRAM**

Project CHILD is a community based creative arts therapy program for child victims of domestic violence and their non-abusive parents located in Bergen County, NJ. Candidates for all positions are required to complete 40 hours of domestic violence training upon hire.

Bilingual Licensed Clinical Social Worker/Therapist– 20-25 hrs/wk. Approximately \$23.00 per hour

Project CHILD is seeking a skilled therapist with at least 1-3 years of professional experience working with families who have experienced domestic violence. MSW+LSW/LCSW or MA+LPC required. Only Bilingual English/Spanish speaking candidates will be considered for this position. Must have a car and a valid driver's license.

It is the function of the Bilingual Therapist to render comprehensive professional assessment, therapeutic and psychoeducational services to adult victims of domestic violence and their children in conjunction with the Project CHILD team. The Bilingual Therapist will provide services to families attending Project CHILD in individual, group and/or filial/family therapy configurations. Duties include, but are not limited to, completing client intakes and assessment interviews, conducting weekly therapy sessions with individuals and/or families, facilitating psychoeducational, parenting and/or therapeutic groups, treatment planning, case management, etc.

This position is part time, 20-25 hours per week, and requires working afternoon and early evening hours 3-4 days per week (approximately 12pm-7pm, with some flexibility). Work hours will be arranged according to the program's schedule and clients' needs.

Van Driver – Approx 20 hrs/wk

The Driver is responsible for providing the safe transportation of children to and from the program office for their therapy appointments. Children are picked up from different locations throughout Bergen County, NJ including their homes, schools, daycare centers, etc. The Driver is also responsible for providing childcare in the Project CHILD office, some light office duties and errands.

We are seeking candidates who are professional and capable of working as a member of a team, as well as independently. Must be child friendly, possess strong initiative, able to communicate clearly and effectively, mature, responsible, flexible and punctual. Experience working with children and knowledge of the Bergen County, NJ area is required. Work experience providing transportation of children is strongly preferred.

Candidates possessing a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) are preferred. Must have a valid driver's license in good standing and a clean driving record, and be capable of driving a 12 passenger van. A clean criminal background check is necessary. Candidates must be at least 25 years of age. Bilingual Spanish speaking candidates preferred.

Work schedule is approximately 20 hours per week including afternoons / early evening hours between 2pm and 8pm, at least 3-4 weekdays per week. Candidate MUST be available to work during these days and times. Position is year-round. \$14 per hour.
