- Complete SAFE in Hunterdon's mandatory agency training or equivalent

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide family therapy services to victims of dv participating in the PALS Program
- Develop and implement individualized treatment plans addressing family relationship issues
- Maintain case files including progress notes, evaluations and recommendations
- Consult outside professionals involved in clients' lives to gather information, assess progress, and coordinate services
- Participate in team case management meetings and clinical supervision
- Complete client statistics on a monthly basis
- Provide parenting support groups to participants of PALS program
- Participate in agency-wide functions, such as fundraisers, community events, speaking engagements, etc.
- Attend monthly staff meetings and agency in-service trainings
- Other duties as assigned by direct supervisor, Management Team, and/or Executive Director
