Systems Advocate**

The Arizona Coalition Against Domestic Violence (AzCADV) is a non-profit membership organization comprised of representatives from Domestic Violence programs and other concerned individuals and groups. The mission of the Coalition is to lead, to advocate, to educate, to collaborate, to end domestic violence in Arizona. AzCADV currently has one full-time Systems Advocate position available. Starting Salary \$24,800 - 31,000 DOE.

The primary responsibilities of this position include working with the Systems Advocacy Coordinator to establish public policy priorities and strategies; meet with legislators and government officials to garner support and sponsorship for bills and/or voice opposition to legislation; provide information and education about public policy issues to domestic violence victim service programs, grassroots activists, allied organizations, and the public; implement assigned projects; advocate for victims and domestic violence programs in policy making committees; provide and organize training on public policy issues and domestic violence, collaborate with community stakeholders. The Systems Advocate upholds the mission, vision and guiding principles of the AzCADV.

Position requirements:

- Bachelors degree in social work, public policy, women's studies or related field or 4+ years equivalent experience
- Ability to work collaboratively as well as independently
- Access to reliable transportation and ability to travel statewide
- Computer literacy
- Public presentation and speaking skills
- Demonstrated ability to complete assignments within established time frames
- Demonstrated team building, problem solving, creative/ analytic thinking skills, and organization skills
- Ability to analyze public policy and its potential effects on victims of domestic violence
- Excellent written, oral communication and listening skills
- Experience in social change advocacy
- Knowledge of domestic violence and related issues and a commitment to ending violence against women
- Demonstrated ability to work in high pressure, limited resource work environment
- Ability to coordinate activities with volunteers, interns, and other agency staff
