Position: Fully Bilingual Interviewer (English/Spanish)

Hours: Part-time position (Average of 15 hours a week)

Position Focus: Economic Empowerment Research- Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) - Spanish-speaking survivors of IPV

Qualifications:

1. Fully Bilingual, Spanish/English
2. Have an understanding of issues related to violence against women Have an understanding of issues of cultural and socioeconomic diversity
3. Have knowledge of basic computer functions, including word processing and email
4. Have a driver's license and access to vehicle, and be available to travel to New Jersey/ New York City locations
5. Excellent time management skills
6. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
7. Be able to commit to the position until spring of 2013

Principal Duties:

1. Conduct interviews with Spanish speaking women who have experienced domestic violence and who have different levels of education using a survey with open and closed questions. This type of interview requires dealing with sensitive topics and confidential information.
2. Meet with participants at different locations in the New Jersey/ New York area
3. Have monthly phone contact with participants
4. Conduct follow-up interviews with participants intermittently over a 14 month period
5. Meet regularly with research team members
6. Assist with other projects
