The YWCA EUC Project Protect has an opening for a Senior Shelter Advocate.

Qualifications: M.A./M.S.W. required; minimum 2 years work experience in domestic violence field. Must have knowledge and understanding of domestic violence and trauma. Must demonstrate cultural competency in experience or education. Excellent verbal and written skills a must. Must possess strong public speaking skills. Knowledge of computer programs including but not limited to Microsoft office, Power Point and Excel. Bilingual – Spanish speaking preferred.

#### Responsibilities:

Senior Shelter advocate will have primary responsibility for the delivery of adjunctive support services within Project Protect shelter. Will create and direct delivery of empowerment curricula for each shelter client, covering topics geared to needs of each resident, and coordinate community services to meet clients' needs. Conduct house meetings and other groups as needed, including workshops provided by advocate and community providers.
